

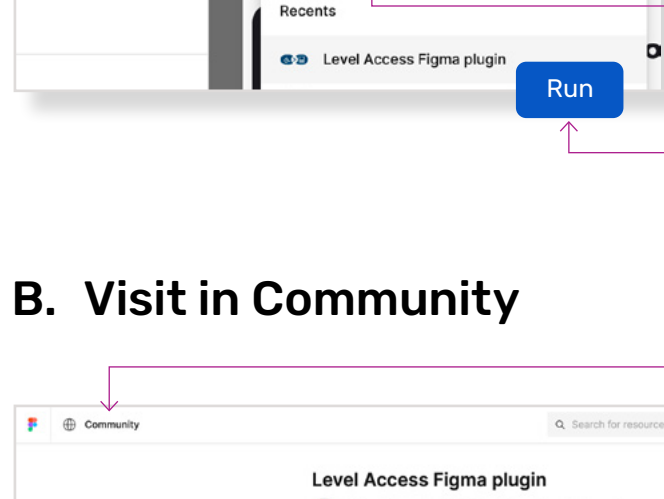


Getting Started with the Figma Plugin

Get proactive with accessibility with the Figma plugin.

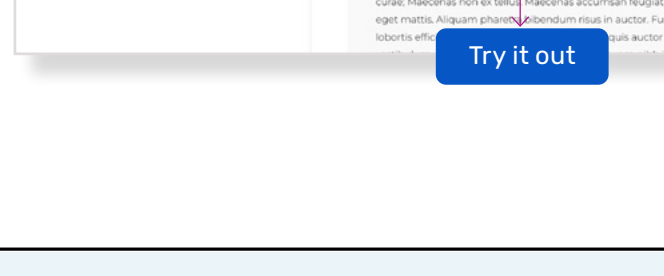
1 Install the Figma Plugin

A. Search in Figma



- Open the plugin menu in Figma
- Search for Level Access
- Click Run!

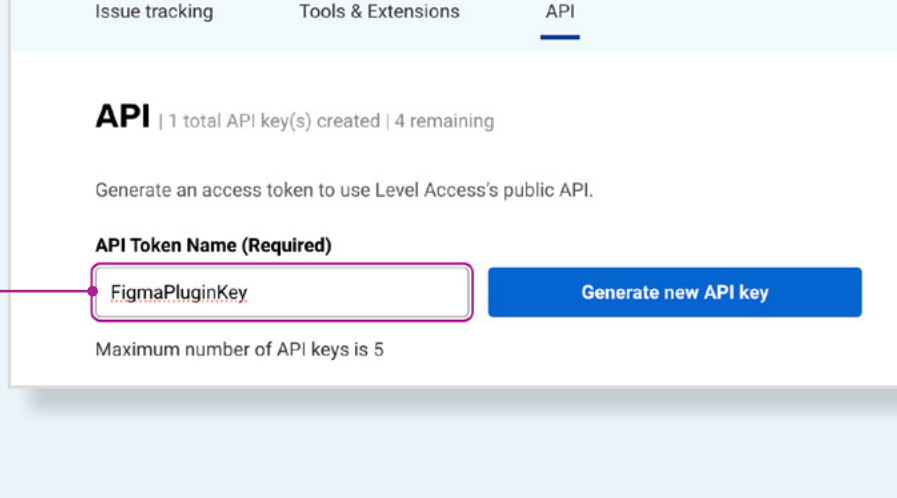
B. Visit in Community



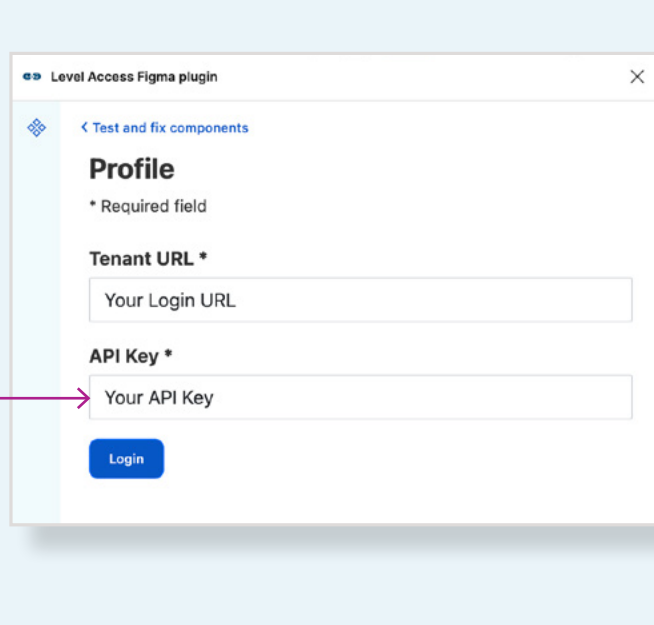
- View our plugin in the [Figma Community](#)

2 Login to the plugin

A. To get started with the Figma plugin, you'll need an API key from the Level Access Platform.



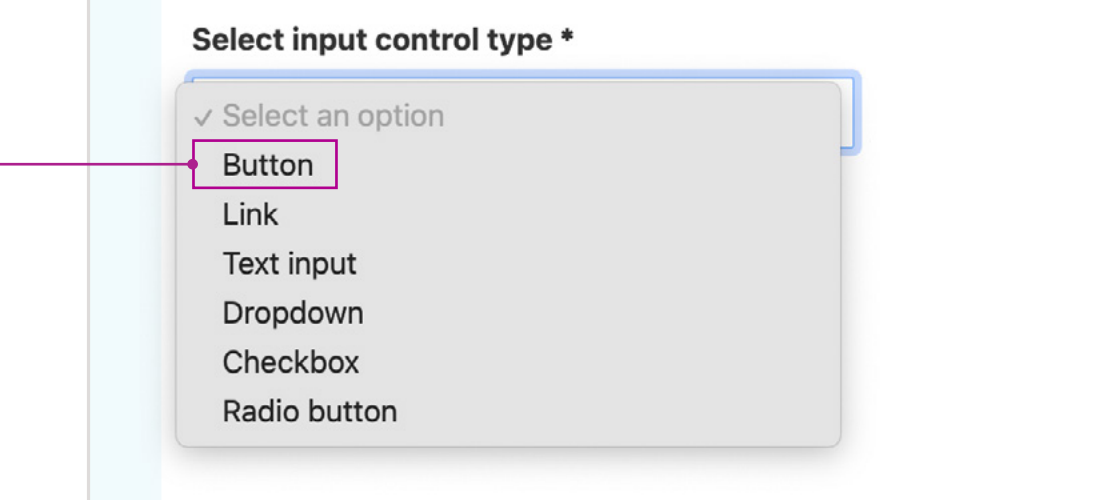
B. Grab an API key from the API page in the platform, and paste it in the plugin.



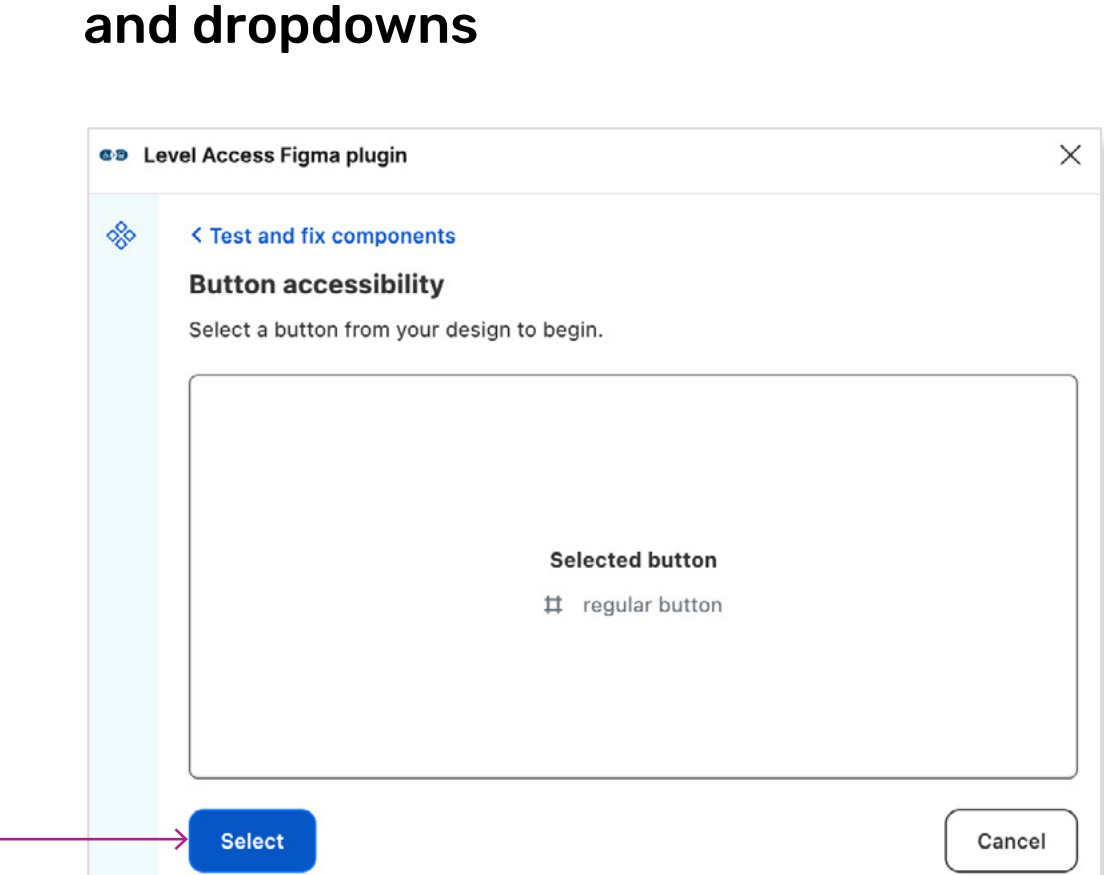
NOTE: Only available to Accelerate and Enterprise packages

B. You can test buttons, links, text input fields, radio buttons, checkboxes, and dropdowns



4 Review results, apply fixes

Four categories of results
